

Privacy statement

1. Personal Data Integrity

IBT respects privacy and treats personal data provided to IBT with care. Personal data will be processed by IBT solely for its own internal purposes and will not be given or sold to third parties. Personal data provided to IBT will be processed and stored in accordance with the Swedish Personal Data Act (SFS 1998:204). IBT will take reasonable steps to ensure that personal data collected is relevant for its intended purpose, accurate, complete, and current.

2. Sharing Information with Business Partners

Personally identifiable data provided to IBT may be accessible to some of IBT's business partners, such as companies we retain to provide assistance to us on specific programs or projects. IBT will require third parties to whom it discloses personal data to protect such data using standards substantially similar to those applied by IBT.

3. Collection of Anonymous Computer Information - Cookies

IBT will not without prior consent collect any personally identifiable information about visitors coming to this website. However, we may collect anonymous information if the visitor's computer is set to allow that type of collection. This type of anonymous information allows us to monitor traffic to our website and survey browsing habits on our website. One of the typical computer techniques we use is "cookies". The use of cookies can be disabled in the visitor's web browser settings.

4. Links to Other Sites

This Privacy Statement applies only to this website and not to third party websites. IBT may provide links to other websites, which we believe may be of interest to our visitors, but we cannot guarantee the privacy standards of websites to which we link or be responsible for the contents of sites other than this one.
